We have been thrilled with the response to our presentation of **Cinderella**. Shona Reppe, the creator, designer, and performer in the production of **Cinderella** is in the words of the Edinburgh Evening News ".....the fairy godmother of puppet theatre." **Cinderella** has toured extensively throughout the UK, Japan, Belgium, Canada and the United States. To quote the New York Times "Shona Reppe's *Cinderella* is unlike any other you have seen. It is a magical and mischievous delight; combining simple storytelling with lush and inventive images."

You will see from the included booking sheet that a number of performers are already sold out and there are just a few tickets left for each of the other performances. Part of the reason for the sell out is that we have capped the capacity to just 150 so that the audience will have a close and personal experience with puppet Cinderella, but also schools are becoming increasingly aware that Windmill shows sell out fast. If you were contemplating booking your school into the performance and the numbers are greater than what is available I have asked BASS to take any request for a wait list in case a school has to cancel their existing booking.

Linked to the production will be professional learning workshops focusing on the craft of puppetry and linking a classic text to performance. For schools who have booked, details will be provided once they have been confirmed.
